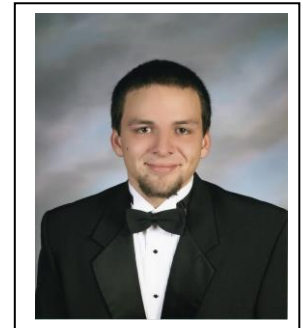


Scott “Impy” Impellizeri Memorial Scholarship

This scholarship is being awarded by John and Tracy Impellizeri in memory of their son, Scott, who tragically lost his life in an auto accident on Sunday, August 7, 2011, in the Hardin Valley community of Knoxville, TN.

Scott was an amazing young man. He was a leader, a mentor and had a unique personality that drew people to him. Scott graduated from Hardin Valley Academy in 2011. He received the Humanitarian Award for his outstanding service as a peer tutor. He was enrolled at Middle Tennessee State University and was preparing to begin his criminal justice studies in August 2011. His goal after graduating from MTSU was to become a SWAT officer with the Knoxville Police Department.

Aside from Scott’s interest in law enforcement, his true passion was helping others. Over the years, Scott had enjoyed volunteering his time with groups such as Special Olympics, Habitat for Humanity and the Music City Quarter Midget Racing Association, which is a racing program for kids ages 5 to 16.

This scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior within Knox County Schools who is pursuing a college education, following the criminal justice path and is dedicated to helping others.

ABOUT THE SCHOLARSHIP:

The purpose of the Scott "Impy" Impellizeri Memorial Scholarship is to encourage and promote the attainment of higher education goals for students who are following the criminal justice path.

SELECTION CRITERIA:

Selection of the scholarship recipient will be based on the following:

- Essay stating why you want to go into the criminal justice field and how you think your work in the criminal justice field will impact the community
- Community service/volunteer activities
- Acceptance into a two or four year college/university
- Letters of recommendation from Knox County high school teachers or counselors
- General school record

ELIGIBILITY:

To be eligible for consideration, the student must:

- Be a graduating senior from a high school within Knox County Schools
- Be accepted into a two or four year college/university
- Complete an application and submit all required attachments

AMOUNT AND USE:

The amount of the scholarship will be \$1,000. Funds from the scholarship are to be used for books, supplies, and other miscellaneous school related expenses.

SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION PROCEDURE AND DEADLINE:

- Complete the application in its entirety, along with the required attachments (as listed below). The information supplied must be accurate and will be kept confidential.

- High school transcript.
